About

[Weed Weapon Long Term](#) is a combination of 3 active ingredients:

- Glyphosate controls existing weeds by moving into the weed and down to the roots.
- Saflufenacil moves into the leaves of existing weeds and blocks photosynthesis causing rapid damage to green parts of the plant this allows glyphosate to enter and assists its movement to the roots.
- Terbutylazine affects both existing weeds and stays active in soil preventing new weed seeds or bulbs germinating and reaching the surface.

Ideal Uses

Waste areas, roadsides, paths, driveways and other non-cultivated areas where weeds are to be suppressed for extended periods.

Directions

Concentrate

1. Shake well before use.
2. Dilute 25 ml in 1 L water. (1 L mix covers 10 m²)
3. Apply using a pressure sprayer onto weed foliage until just wet.
4. Spray ground where weeds tend to grow and long term prevention is required (e.g. gaps between pavers, gravel driveways and paths).

For best results

- For post-emergent control apply when weeds are actively growing. Expect visible effects in as little as two days* with the concentrate.
- For pre-emergent control use at any time but longest control is achieved with spring application.

Tips & Tricks

- Effects can take up to 7 days to show on some tough weeds or weeds in deep shade. In these cases a second application is recommended after 7 days.
- Do not use product if you intend replanting.
- Best applied in sunny weather with temperatures over 10°C.
- Spray in calm conditions to reduce the chance of overspray onto desirable plants. If desirable plants are sprayed, immediately hose off with water.

Caution

Not for use in areas to be cultivated.

May leave a visible white residue on dark surfaces. This will weather off.

Concentrate: 300 g/L Terbutylazine, 141 g/L Glyphosate and 1.43 g/L Saflufenacil.
